



BOSTON — The Rev. Accelynne Williams spent much of his life speaking out against drugs and alcohol, but friends now bitterly say he died a victim of the war on drugs.

Williams, 75, a retired minister, died of a heart attack Friday, 45 minutes after a 13-member police SWAT team mistakenly stormed his apartment, chased him into his bedroom and handcuffed him during a bungled drug raid.
